A French participant who is between 14 and 17 years old lives with his/her American partner and family on private arrangements for a two to three week period to be defined with his/her parents (in June, July or August). The American family is expected to provide a warm and secure environment and include the French participant in family events. The American student then has the opportunity to travel to France and, in turn, discovers a new country and lifestyle. We are sure that this experience will bring memories and friendship that will last a lifetime, and will impart several benefits: regularly converse with a native speaker, explore the option of visiting Le Havre, Normandy, France, become familiar with the French culture, and show college admissions officers the participant is curious and responsible, taking the initiative to broaden their academic life.
