French Immersion Camp Debuts this Summer at CAMP FASTB

Immersion-The Best Way to Learn a Language: The reason immersion works is that vocabulary is learned in context, through observing and listening, the same way we all experienced learning our native tongue. At Camp FASTB, the language of instructors and counselors is French and campers will hear the language used in the context of daily activities. Because

the camp will have multiple fluent French speakers on staff, campers will also observe staff interaction in French. As time passes in this environment, campers will begin to understand and will eventually be able to speak some words.

"We believe the camp will be a fun and relaxed introduction to French language and culture for campers and their families," explains Camp

FASTB Founder, Willy LeBihan, "and hopefully Camp FASTB will spark a continued interest in language and becoming bilingual."

As with The French American School of Tampa Bay, Camp FASTB will incorporate a lot of music into each week's travels to new French destinations.
